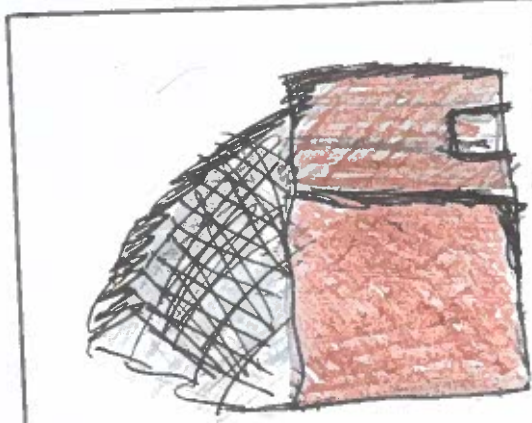


In a Viking House

A Viking house would be made out of long wooden logs and the light would be dim. 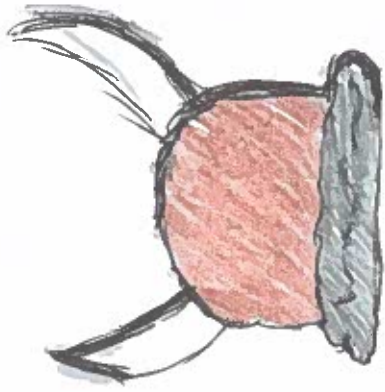


Viking Sword & Shield

ACCESSORIES

On the walls, wool would be gently woven to make tapestries to be hung up. There would be no floorboards or carpets, instead, there would be rushes. Only the rich would own beds, whilst the poor would sleep on benches laid out with rugs. The mattresses would be made out of straw or feathers. The bed covers are made of animal fur. There's much less furnishing compared to a modern day house. Weapons, tools and clothes would be stored in chests.
