Past Tense Verbs:

Past Tense Verbs:

- (Read) it might seem like no fun to have someone read you a book with no pictures.
- (Mean) that doesn't even mean anything!
- (taught) I am a monkey who taught myself to read.

Present Tense Verbs:

- (Please) can I stop reading, please?
- (Bonk) bonk. I didn't want to say that.
- (Glug) glug glug glug my face is a bug...

Future Tense Verbs: The common tense between the 2 story's is present tense, the past tense is equal to the present tense, but the future tense has no verbs.
